Turning Point (WACH) is a 501©3 nonprofit organization based in Wareham. Turning Point is a twenty-year old social service agency that provides supportive services to individuals and families who are facing life challenges and as a result are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Turning Point helps with:

- > heat and utility bills
- > rental assistance
- access to emergency food and clothing
- > tents and blankets
- essential baby items
- life threatening weather shelter
- > direction to fuel assistance, housing, SNAP and CHAMP applications
- > referrals to treatment centers
- mentoring and more

In 2024, Turning Point served 1619 clients (both adults and children). During this period, eleven individuals that were homeless worked with a housing case manager to find permanent housing placement.

Provides diapers and other essential baby items for struggling young families, through donations from around the community.
