What I can do this year:

Check one or more (but not too many \mathfrak{S} !) and keep this page in a visible place:

REDUCE!
Reduce my use of plastic bags, single use plastic water bottles, Styrofoam and other
non-sustainable products. Start with "I don't need a bag" when purchasing just a few items and
remember to use your reuseable bag- especially for the produce section, available online at
Grove Collaborative or in your local Stop & Shop or Shaw's
Unless I need it for record-keeping, don't ask for a receipt or have them email it (and tell
them before they print it!)
Use more sustainable options for paper products: tissues, paper towels, toilet paper
(bamboo, recycled paper). https://www.grove.co/
Use fewer K-cups or find ones that are refillable or made from recycled products
Choose food and beverages in metal, glass or cardboard containers instead of plastic when
possible: i.e. salad dressing, soda, olive oil etc.
REUSE!
Reuse non-recyclable items at least 3 or more times before throwing out.
Start a compost bin/pile for your food waste.
Get creative with old food containers, use to store items or turn into a craft project at
home, at church or another group you belong to, before recycling them.
