Good Shepherd Friends,

"Who is my neighbor?" This is the question a lawyer asks Jesus in the Gospel passage we have this coming Sunday. The lawyer knew that the greatest commandment is to love God and to love one's neighbor. So, what he really wanted to know is who he didn't have to love; who was not included as neighbor. Did he have to love those deemed to be sinners? Did he have to love those who were not his family members? Did he have to love those who were not Jewish? The lawyer wanted to tighten the circle of inclusivity when it came to love. But this was not the way of Jesus.

Jesus used a parable to teach us that we are to see everyone as neighbor, as family. And he emphasized this by having the Samaritan as the hero of the story. The Jewish people saw the Samaritans as their enemies, yet in the story it is the Samaritan who helps the person in need. In doing this, Jesus was widening the circle of who we should love. We should love everyone. We should show kindness to everyone. That's why at Good Shepherd all are welcome here, just as we are.

Who is outside your circle of inclusivity when it comes to loving? With God's help, let us work to ever widen our circle of inclusivity.

Coffee Hour Hosts Needed

Every Sunday, following the 10am Sunday Service, coffee hour is held in the Church Hall. Coffee hour is an opportunity for us to further get to know one another and share our lives with one another. Every household is invited to host coffee hour, which follows our 10am Sunday Service. You can host by yourselves or join with another household. Coffee hour hosts are asked to bring a quart size carton of half-n-half, a half-gallon carton of juice, and some snacks to feed 6-8 children and about 30 adults (for example: cake, pastry, cookies, brownies, cheese and crackers, fruit, cut up veggies, etc.). Hosts arrive at the church by 9:15 to set up for coffee hour. Judy Govoni will be there to assist you. Hosts are also asked to clean up after coffee hour. The idea is that each household would host coffee hour about every three or four months. The sign-up list and more information can be found on the food table during coffee hour.

Mid-Week Eucharist

On Wednesdays at Noon, there is a celebration of the Eucharist in the church, which is open to all. This is an opportunity to gather for prayer and reflection; and be reminded of God's presence between Sundays. For those on your lunch break, the celebration of the mid-week Eucharist is approximately 20 minutes.

Prayer Request Book

In the back of the church on Sunday mornings, there is a Prayer Request Book. As you come into the church each Sunday, you are welcome to record in the Prayer Request Book the names of those who need prayers. During the prayers of the people, we pray for "all those whose names have been recorded in the Prayer Request Book."

Good Shepherd Table

Good Shepherd's Table serves a free in-person meal, which is open to the public, every Thursday at 4:30pm. Take-out meals are available from 4:30-4:45pm for those who choose not to eat indoors with others. Like all other indoor church functions, if you are not feeling well, please do not participate in the Good Shepherd Table indoor dining.

The Good Shepherd Sunday Nursery

The Good Shepherd Sunday Nursery, for children through kindergarten age, is closed for the summer. It will reopen on Sunday, September 7.

Sunday School

Our Good Shepherd Sunday School, which is held during the first half of our 10am Sunday Service (usually on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month), is on summer break. Sunday School will resume on Sunday, September 7.
