Turning Point (WACH) is a 501©3 nonprofit organization based in Wareham. Turning Point is a twenty-year old social service agency that provides supportive services to individuals and families who are facing life challenges and as a result are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Turning Point helps with:

- heat and utility bills
- rental assistance
- access to emergency food and clothing
- tents and blankets
- essential baby items
- life threatening weather shelter
- direction to fuel assistance, housing, SNAP and CHAMP applications
- referrals to treatment centers
- mentoring and more



In 2025, Turning Point served 2,071 clients (both adults and children). During this period, five individuals that were homeless worked with a housing case manager to find permanent housing placement.

Turning Point Special Programs

Baby Point

Provides diapers and other essential baby items for struggling young families, through donations from around the community.

Holiday Magic

Receives substantial support from the public and others to ensure a successful and happy holiday for an additional 206 families including more than 467 children.
