Thank you for participating in the “Wareham Walks for the Homeless” fundraiser, in support of Turning Point and its work to help the homeless and near homeless of our area. This walk will not only raise funds but will also increase our awareness of the number of people in our community who are homeless or near homeless.

The Walk begins at the Church of the Good Shepherd 74 High Street, continues down Center Street, right onto Main St, up Sandwich Rd, right onto Depot St, right onto Minot Ave, onto Main Street, left onto Center St, up to Good Shepherd.

The Walk will take place rain or shine!

Guidelines for the Walk:

1. Walkers may collect donations as soon as they receive the donation sheets.
2. Each donor making a donation should write his/her own name and pledge amount. ***Walkers are asked to collect the donation money in advance.***
3. The Walk begins at 1pm.
4. Registration for the Walk is from Noon-12:45pm on Sunday, May 17<sup>th</sup>.
5. On the Day of the Walk, please submit your sponsor form and donations.
6. **All checks should be made out to “Turning Point”.**
7. No running or jogging please. Participants are encouraged to wear hats and sunscreen if it's sunny or bring rain gear if it's rainy. Please use the sidewalks and crosswalks along the route.
8. There will be snacks and water available for all walkers at the Church of the Good Shepherd and at the Church of the Nazarene. Walkers are asked to bring their own reusable water bottles, which can be filled at both churches. Bringing your own reusable water bottles will help us better care for our environment.
