Good Shepherd's Guild Rummage Sale

Good Shepherd Guild is looking for clean clothes, shoes, household linens, white elephant items, books, and games for our spring rummage sale on June 27th, 9-1pm. Coffee Hour Hosts Needed

We have no one signed up to host coffee hour this coming Sunday (June 28) and most of July and August. Every Sunday, following the 10am Sunday Service, coffee hour is held in the Church Hall. Coffee hour is an opportunity for us to further get to know one another and share our lives with one another. Every household is invited to host coffee hour, which follows our 10am Sunday Service. You can host by yourselves or join with another household. Coffee hour hosts are asked to bring a quart size carton of half-n-half, a half-gallon carton of juice, and some snacks to feed 6-8 children and about 30 adults (for example: cake, pastry, cookies, brownies, cheese and crackers, fruit, cut up veggies, etc.). Hosts arrive at the church by 9:15 to set up for coffee hour. Judy Govoni will be there to assist you. Hosts are also asked to clean up after coffee hour. The idea is that each household would host coffee hour about every three or four months. The sign-up list and more information can be found on the wall behind the coffee hour food table.

Turning Point Wareham Looking for Volunteers

Turning Point Wareham is seeking volunteers to contribute their time and talent in support of our Wareham neighbors in need. It is a not-for-profit, community-based organization serving as a day resource and referral

center for those facing housing instability. We provide collaborative, respectful, and supportive services and are committed to empowering individuals who are ready to help themselves.

Intake Volunteer – reporting to the Executive Director, interacts with clients seeking assistance, guidance, and support for a variety of life challenges. Training provided. Minimum three-hour commitment each week.

Public Relations Volunteer – reporting to the WACH President, the PR volunteer will be responsible for framings one or two press releases each month relating to Turning Point activities and programs. The PR volunteer will contribute to the quarterly Turning Point Newsletter and will provide input to other communication pieces for Turning Point use. Commitment is a minimum of five hours each month.

Social Media Volunteer – reporting to the WACH President, volunteer will have experience with website management, Facebook postings, and FB oversight. Volunteers may also have experience with other social media platforms that may benefit Turning Point. Commitment is a minimum of five hours each month.

Food Pantry Wish List

Church of the Good Shepherd is partnering with Damien’s Place Food Pantry by provided needed items for those using the pantry.
