Good Shepherd Friends,

On Sunday we will hear the following parable from Matthew's Gospel:

"A sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some seeds fell on the path, and the birds came and ate them up. Other seeds fell on rocky ground, where they did not have much soil, and they sprang up quickly, since they had no depth of soil. But when the sun rose, they were scorched; and since they had no root, they withered away. Other seeds fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked them. Other seeds fell on good soil and brought forth grain, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. Let anyone with ears listen!"

God is constantly scattering seeds of the kingdom of God in our lives. These seeds are meant to build up the kingdom of God, to make the world more loving, compassionate, and just. These seeds come in the form of an inspiration to perform acts of goodness and kindness. They come through the words or actions of others which inspire us. They come from the word of God. They come from our quiet time in prayer and reflection. The seeds are scattered and then it is up to the soil that is our lives to accept and nurture these seeds, so they bear fruit in the world.

But not all soil is the same. Sometimes the soil of our lives is not too receptive of the seeds of the kingdom of God. The good news is that we can do something about this. With God's help, we can make our lives more receptive and nurturing of these seeds so they can bear the fruit of the kingdom of God and make the world a brighter and better place. How is the soil of your life? Does it need tending to?

I encourage you to examine how you can make your soil more receptive to the seeds of the kingdom of God. What are the weeds in your life that suck up all your energy and choke off the ways of Jesus? What do you need to remove from your life, with God's help, in order to be a better partner with Jesus in advancing the kingdom of God in the world?

Coffee Hour Hosts Needed

We have no one signed up to host coffee hour for most of July and August. Every Sunday, following the 10am Sunday Service, coffee hour is held in the Church Hall. Coffee hour is an opportunity for us to further get to know one another and share our lives with one another. Every household is invited to host coffee hour, which follows our 10am Sunday Service. You can host by yourselves or join with another household. Coffee hour hosts are asked to bring a quart size carton of half-n-half, a half-gallon carton of juice, and some snacks to feed 6-8 children and about 30 adults (for example: cake, pastry, cookies, brownies, cheese and crackers, fruit, cut up veggies, etc.). Hosts arrive at the church by 9:15 to set up for coffee hour. Judy Govoni will be there to assist you. Hosts are also asked to clean up after coffee hour. The idea is that each household would host coffee hour about every three or four months. The sign-up list and more information can be found on the wall behind the coffee hour food table.
